Heritage Apple Varieties 2025

We have grafted a range of heritage (or Heirloom) apple varieties on dwarfing rootstocks to create compact trees with high yields.

Crimson Bramley: A rosy red variety of the popular cooking apple The Bramley. Needs two pollinating varieties.



Herrings Pippin Excellent eating and cooking apple. Fruit large, deep green, coloured crimson on one side. Flesh crisp but tender when ripe. Spicy flavour, pleasing aroma.



Egremont Russet: Egremont Russet is a classic English russet apple from the Victorian era. With a firm flesh and nutty flavour, good eating and juicing apple.



William Crump: An intensely flavoured English eating apple, related to Cox and Worcester Pearmain. Small but crisp on the outside yet sweet and juicy inside



Baron Ward - Raised at Elton Manor, Nottingham by Samuel Bradley in 1850. First exhibited in 1859. Fruits have soft, white flesh with a tart flavour. Cooking apple.

Other fruits below:

Gogi Berry: Large spreading shrub bearing pink flowers in late summer followed by edible Gogi berries: 10€

Peche de Vigne: bearing small but intensely flavoured peaches for eating, cooking and making liqueurs – the name 'Peche de Vigne' derives from its use grown at the end of rows of vines to detect early signs of disease in the vines: 12€

Strawberry Grape: A variety of table grape grown for eating with cheese, in fruit salad or on their own, with a mild strawberry flavour to the grapes: 18€

Chaenomeles 'Cameo' (Japanese Quince): Bears pink flowers in spring followed by fragrant quinces, high in pectin, used in jellies and jams: 12€

Josta Berry: A cross between a black currant and a gooseberry, the fruits being larger than a black current and sweeter than a gooseberry: 12€

Redcurrant: produces masses of red currants in late spring, used for jams, jellies, fruit salad and puddings: 14€

Amelanchier canadensis: (June Berry) bears masses of pretty white blossom in late April/early May followed by fruits similar to a blueberry, also decorative with fantastic autumn colour: 14€

Sichuan Peppercorn: Hardy shrub/small tree bearing masses of fragrant Sichuan peppercorns in late summer: 20€
